



Policy of allowing dogs at Outdoors@hay

Outdoors@hay currently allows dogs to come with their owners to our site and ask that dog owners read and comply with our conditions when visiting.

We would like to point out that we are primarily an activity centre where the grounds are used regularly for different activities by people of various ages. So it is important to us that our grounds are kept clean and free from unsupervised dogs.

Despite assurances from dog owners that their dog is the best thing on four legs they still give cause for us to consider not allowing dogs. Due to *some* irresponsible owners we have been forced to issue a policy on bringing dogs, which we will regularly review.

Please read the following conditions if you intend to bring your dog to our site and agree to comply with them.

- Please specify when booking that you would like to bring your dog(s) so that we are aware.
- Dogs are not to roam free on site: They are to be tethered by your tent or on a lead at all times.
- They must not be left unattended on site. (Please also note that dogs are not allowed onto the Hay Festival site)
- All dog mess must be cleared up and disposed of in the bins
- Please do not exercise/walk your dogs on site, this includes the verges outside our gate that we maintain. We can provide information on arrival of where to walk your dog.
- Owners of continuously noisy dogs will be asked to take action to stop them disturbing other users.

All of the above apply even if you are the **only** people on site.
